SouthWestern Academic Health Network (SWAHN) Mental Health & Addiction Symposium to be held this Monday at Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare

WHAT:

On May 2nd, the SouthWestern Academic Health Network (SWAHN) will host a Research and Innovation Symposium addressing family peer support of individuals with mental health or addiction-related concerns. The goal of the event is to increase the knowledge about family/caregiver mental health/addiction support initiatives in Southwestern Ontario. SWAHN, a network focused on integrated excellence in research, education and clinical practice, aims to foster collaboration between academic, hospital and community organizations in order to improve patient and population health.

"This is the perfect opportunity to kick-off Mental Health Week. As a healthcare organization that continues to serve and advance our Mental Health programs, Hôtel-Dieu Grace Healthcare is excited to be involved in events such as the Symposium that begins to bridge academic and community research in mental health, "said Rob Moroz, Director of Community Mental Health.

Ms. Joy Lang, a member of a Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) Middlesex family support group, is planning to offer her personal perspective on the value of family peer support. Following the presentations, symposium participants will engage in discussions with the intention of encouraging more attention to research related to family peer support.
