

Update: Nutrition Research Project Team

Retrospective Study: Perioperative Malnutrition and Frailty in Older Adults Undergoing Elective Surgery

 Principal Investigators: Dr. Janet Madill, Brescia University College and Dr. Ava John-Baptiste, Epidemiology & Biostatistics/Public Health, Western University

Prospective Study:

Perioperative Nutrition in Older Adults Scheduled for Elective Surgery: Dietetic Consultation in the Community

- Results from the retrospective study will inform the prospective study
- Developing a model to improve perioperative patient care and better connect hospital and community care (starting with London Health Sciences Centre and Thamesview Family Health Team in Chatham).



Updates: Opioid Reduction Project Team

- Focus: The spread and augmentation of an opioid reduction initiative to reduce prescribing across the region, starting in surgical and emergency units
- Establishing an integrated knowledge translation plan to encourage practice change
- Building awareness and identifying champions across the region to advance the initiative.
